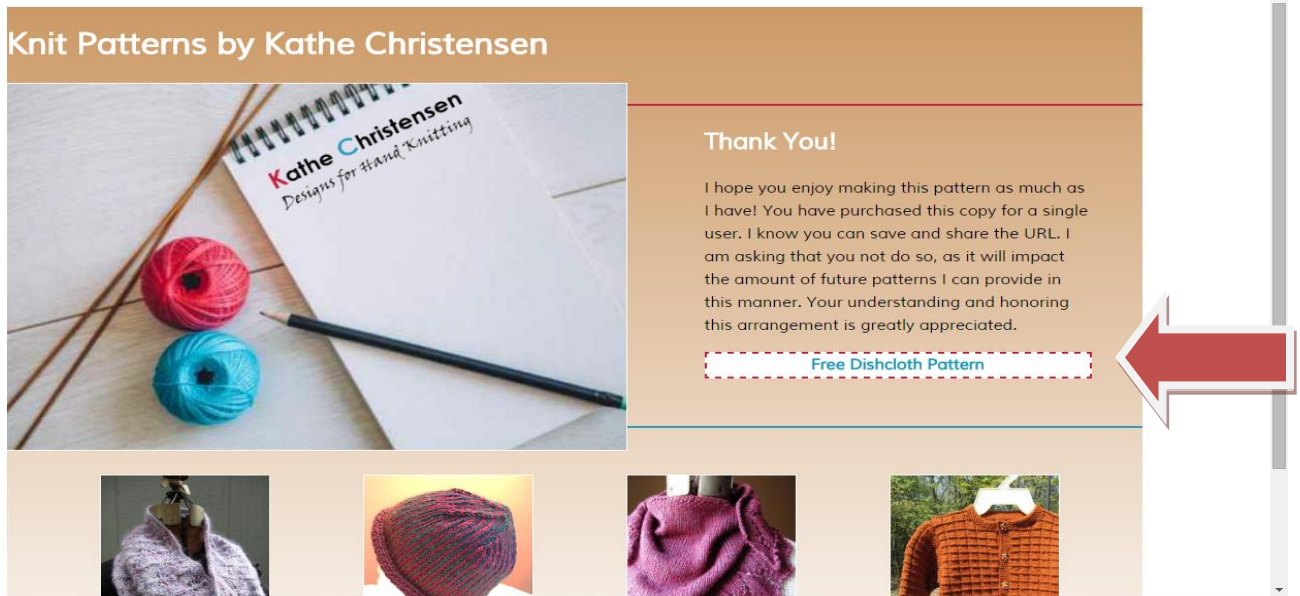


- To purchase additional patterns, browse through my categories (Cowls and Scarves, etc) and click the "Buy Now" button to purchase any pattern you wish.

Easy Dishcloth

KC 154

SIZE: Approx. 9 by 9 inches.

GAUGE: 16 sts and 32 rows = 4 inches in garter stitch

NEEDLES: US size 8 needles

YARN: 150 yards solid light colored worsted weight cotton yarn. Model knit using one 2 oz. ball of Sugar 'n Cream Yarn.

Dishcloth:

Cast on 35 sts.

Knit each row (garter stitch) for 2-1/2 inches.

Continue in Block Stitch Pattern as follows:

Row 1 (WS): K10 sts, P15 sts, K10 sts.

Row 2 (RS): Knit all stitches

Repeat rows 1 and 2 for 4 inches, ending with Row 1.

Knit each row (garter stitch) for 2-1/2 inches.

Bind off loosely and weave in ends.

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Abbreviations: K = knit; P = purl; RS = right side; sts = stitches;
WS = wrong side.
