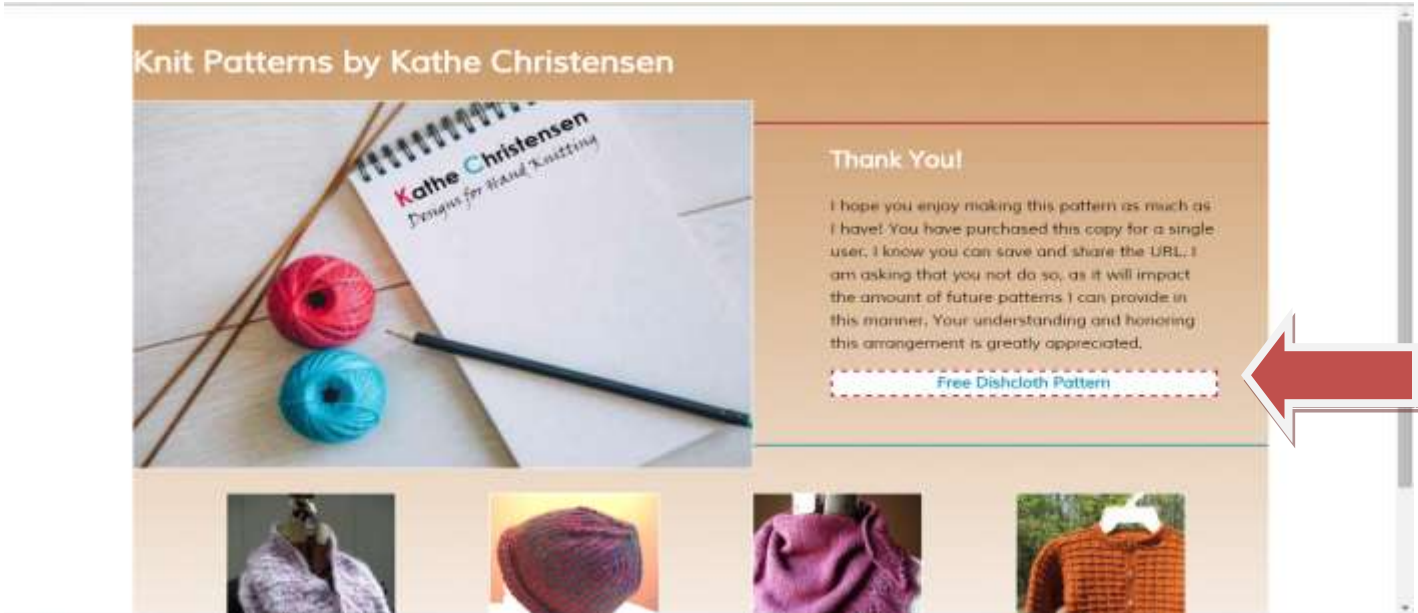


- To purchase additional patterns, browse through my categories (Cowls and Scarves, etc) and click the "Buy Now" button to purchase any pattern you wish.

RIBBED CAP

KC 161

SIZE: Small – to fit 20-22" head circumference.

Medium – to fit 22-24" head circumference.

Large – to fit 24-26" head circumference.

NEEDLES: US size 6 (4.0 mm), - 16" circular or size needed to obtain gauge and set of US size 6 (4.0 mm) double point needles.

YARN: Small - 150 yards DK or light worsted weight yarn

Medium – 175 yards DK or light worsted weight yarn

Large – 200 yards DK or light worsted weight yarn

NOTIONS: Stitch marker, row counter, tapestry needle.

GAUGE: 34 sts and 30 rnds = 4 inches in 2x2 Rib, unstretched.

Instructions are for size small, sizes medium and large are in brackets []. If only one number is given it applies to all sizes.

Hat

With circular needle cast on 112 [120, 128] sts. Place marker for beginning of round and join for working in the round, being careful not to twist stitches.

Work in 2x2 ribbing (K2, P2) until piece measures 6.5" [7, 7.5]", or desired length, from cast on edge. (Add 2" more if you want to turn up the bottom edge of the hat.)

Shape Crown

Note: Switch to DPN's when needed.

Rnd 1: *K2tog, P2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Rnds 2-5: Change to 1x1 ribbing (K1, P1) and work even for 4 rounds.

Rnd 6: *K2tog; repeat from* to end of round.

Rnd 7: *Knit all stitches.

Rnd 8: *K2tog; repeat from * to end of round.

Cut yarn, draw through remaining stitches and secure.

Weave in ends and block lightly.



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Abbreviations: DPN = double pointed needles; K = knit; K2tog = knit 2 stitches together; P2tog = purl 2 stitches together; Rnd(s) = round; sts = stitches.
